Employability skills are developed to prepare you for work, including CV writing, interview preparation, applying for jobs, personal development and managing finance.

Once you have completed your work placement, you will have a discussion with your personal development coach and employer to discuss progression and include an interview, reference, and impartial advice and guidance.
